Dear Parents and Community Members,

Dear Parents and Community Members, During the 2014-2015 school year, all students in the state took new statewide assessments called Smarter Balanced. These assessments replaced the OAKS reading, writing, and math assessments. Smarter Balanced assessments are more in-depth, going beyond standardized multiple choice tests, and are aligned with the new standards being taught. The new content standards set higher expectations for students meaning the expectations for student achievement are higher than they used to be. As a result, it is likely that fewer students will score at the higher achievement levels on the assessments, especially the first few years. Results should improve as students have more years of instruction based on the new standards.

Being the first year the assessment was given, no school received an overall State School Report Card Rating. However, you will see school

wide results on the following pages but no overall ratings were given to schools this year.

Based on the results reported, this first year Liberty Elementary reported:

- Reading 46% met/exceeded state standards
- Math 37% met/exceeded state standards

As part of our efforts to increase academic success for all of our students and to provide targeted instruction for students K-5, our teachers will be receiving additional training this year to provide even higher quality instruction in our classrooms in lesson design, Common Core State Standards, reading, writing and mathematics.

As always, we thank you for being involved in your child's education and for being partners with us to ensure our students are college and career ready.

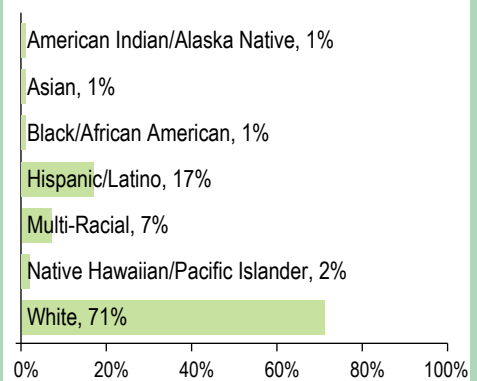

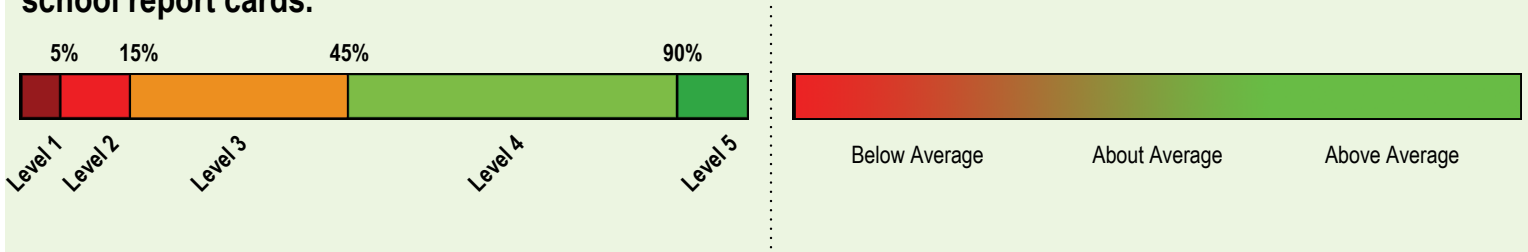
